### 1.2 MATERIALS

- A. Flooring system is low-emitting for LEED.

Retain first paragraph below if wood flooring is required to be certified for LEED.

- B. Forest certification by an FSC-accredited certification body.
- C. [Field-Finished] [Factory-Finished] Wood Flooring: [Solid strip] [Solid parquet] [Engineered strip] [Engineered parquet].
  - 1. Species: [Red oak] [White oak] [Ash] [Beech] [Maple] [Black cherry] <Insert species>.
